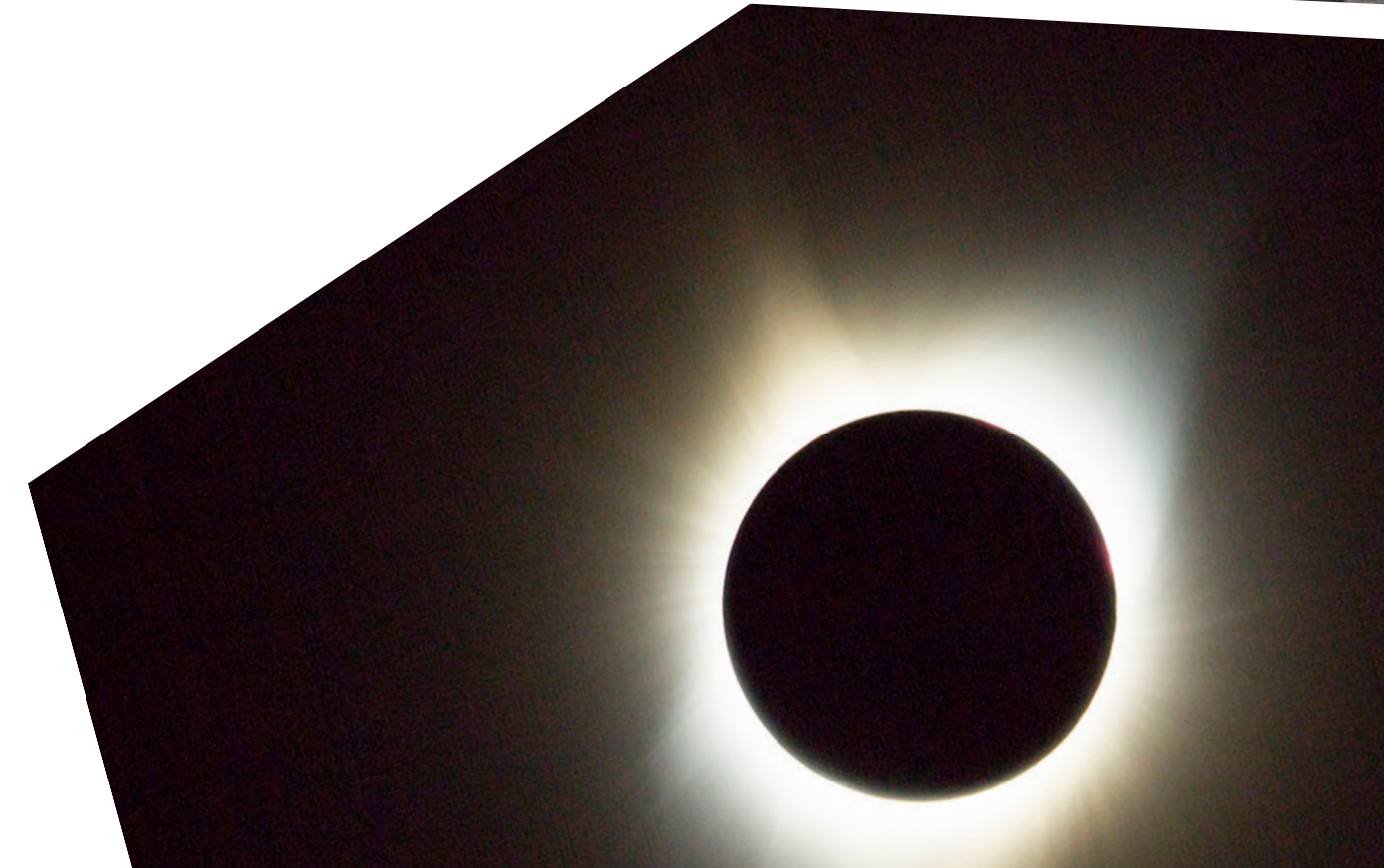


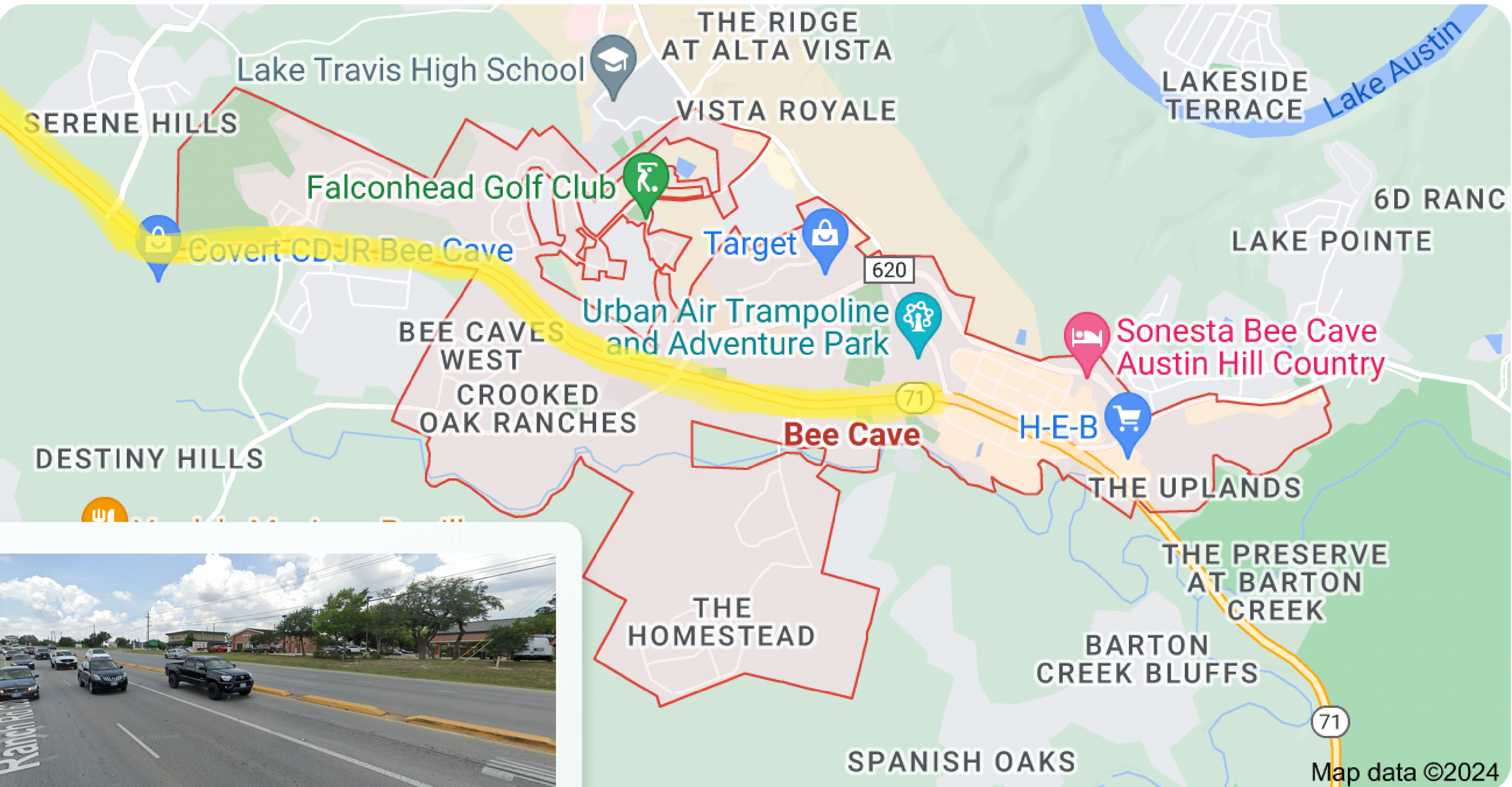

Take Aways

- Building/Inventory: Identify emergency water shut-off points and bleed pipes.
- Palletizing Inventory: Elevate items to prevent freezing during power outages.
- Landlord Prep: Confirm the landlord's plan for water and power in emergencies.
- Insurance: Review insurance coverage for potential weather-related damages.
- Contact Info: Ensure all contacts are accessible at home or on Google Drive.
- Weather Instructions: Establish a nearby contact for checking on things during bad weather.
- Remote Work: Confirm staff's ability to work remotely.
- Preparedness Check: Inquire about staff needs for job preparation.
- Contingency Plan: Outline pay policies for staff stuck at home for an extended period.
- Social Media: Post a message for timely updates.
- Google Hours: Ensure business hours are current.
- Voicemail Update: Change outgoing voicemail to reflect any changes.
- Remote Message Check: Regularly check and respond to messages remotely.
- Website Banner: Display a banner on your website for important announcements.
